**Parking:** Campus parking is at a premium. While visiting Lukenda Alumni House you are welcome to park in our small parking lot, with overflow in the Library (Lot J). Other parking is available behind the Cisler Center/ CAS (Lot E) or Arts Center (Lot K). Parking for Laker hockey is \$3 at the Norris Center (Lot A/B) or at the church across the street from the Center. Tailgate parking inside the tennis courts is free from 5-6 pm on Saturday.

The **14** remaining buildings from **Fort Brady** are listed on a state or national historic register.
