CORONAVIRUS UPDATE


As part of the ongoing commitment to the safety and well-being of the University community, LSSU implemented the Four Pillars of Laker Safety in Fall 2020 which emphasized the wearing of face masks, social distancing, stepped-up cleaning and personal and social responsibility with most courses being taught on-line.
